## Egypt is lighthouse of art

The birth of the Faculty of Fine Arts in Cairo (formerly the School of Fine Arts) in the first decade of the 20th century represented the torch of enlightenment and the realization of cultural renaissance and the revival of arts and architecture, which are the foundations of Egypt's civilisation. Over a century, this lighthouse helped the creation of a brilliant balance of assala (originality) and Contemporaniety (modernism) by setting the stage for an interactive relationship between the Egyptian culture on the one hand and cultural trends in the advanced world on the other hand. In its capacity as a civilisation broadcasting edifice, the Faculty of Fine Arts enhanced Egypt's pioneering cultural and artistic role. The faculty's initiatives coincided with state-sponsored efforts to open art galleries and centers of artistic creativity. Prestigious state awards and prizes, such as the Mubarak Award, the State Prize of Merit, the State Prize of Encouragement, etc. were also announced. In the meantime, the Faculty of Fine Arts won international prestige after its graduates participated successfully in major art events and competitions at home and overseas. Works created by Egyptian artists are now invaluable part of art collections in major museums in Egypt and foreign countries. Biographies of Egyptian artists and their achievements are broadly published in international who's who and encyclopedias.
Taking into account the fact that time-honoured civilisation is the yardstick of the nation's history, 100 years are not considered a long time in this respect. The foundations of arts and assala in Egypt over the 20th century display elements and potentials of Egypt's history and renaissance, which motivate the country's efforts to carve a niche for itself under tomorrow's sun.
Arts have always been the melting pot for the native heritage and imported cultures so much that Egypt has been internationally acknowledged for being an open society, which encourages different philosophies and civilisations to combine. God bless Egypt the lighthouse of global culture and enlightenment.

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## Establishment of fine arts and the revival of creativity in Egypt

Fine Arts was the cornerstone of the 4000-years old Egyptian civilisation. Arts inspired ancient Egyptian artists to express and broadcast religious rituals. Artistic achievements alone have survived from the ancient Egyptian civilisation. They constitute a strong evidence that fine arts under the ancient Egyptian civilisation reached full maturity, giving birth to admirable elements, which arrest the attention of today's art lovers worldwide. Coming face to face with the ancient Egyptian artist, contemporary colleagues would immediately show their respect to his bewitching arts.
Over several centuries the Egyptian nation had witnessed invasions spearheaded by different foreign countries, which deliberately sough to undermine strong social fabrics in society and eliminate the basic infrastructure of its civilisation. There were also incessant hostile attempts to suppress the Egyptian people's potentials of creativity. Refusing to give in, gifted Egyptians revealed their creativity into simple handicrafts. Egyptians were lagging behind when fine arts under the Renaissance were gaining popularity in European societies, deepening their roots in the cultural circles and shining brightly in museums and art galleries. Specialised magazines and periodicals published in Europe also highlighted uninterrupted sequels of artistic and intellectual trends sweeping the West. The frustration of Egyptians in this respect was unavoidable after the developments of their civilisation had undergone interruptions for centuries.
The outbreak of the dawn of the 20th century at home coincided with growing attempts by members of the intelligentsia to drawthe nation's attention to the importance of fine arts in society. Championing an Egyptian cultural renaissance, these pioneers stressed the fine arts' potentials to upgrade the citizen and the nation as well. Accordingly, in collaboration with different mechanisms, fine arts ushered the Egyptian nation into a modern society appreciating the influence of civilisation and progress in this respect. It goes without saying that the language of fine arts is the most effective and communicative of all other languages. Such an atmosphere in the Egyptian society led to the opening of the School of Fine Arts in 1908. Although its first students had to walk in the footsteps of their foreign teachers, they did their best to establish their identity in the new artistic medium and masterfully control techniques and tools to break artistic codes. Undoubtedly, the national heritage and civilisation embedded in the souls of the Egyptians were expecting the proper moment to celebrate its reawakening. It was no surprise that the generation of pioneers came up with full-grown and admirable art, which stressed the artistic talent of the Egyptian artist. These successes were represented by sculptures made by Mahmoud Mukhtar, and paintings made by Ragheb Ayyad, Yussef Kamel, Ahmed Sabri and Mohamed Hassan. The community of artistic talents in Egypt increased remarkably. Over decades, successors of these pioneering artists managed to reveal different artistic trends and techniques. They also achieved innovative visions and surprising aesthetic values. New generations, meanwhile, succeeded in proposing a reconciliation of assala (originality) and modernism, which swept the Egyptian cultural circles.
Marking the 100th anniversary of fine arts in Egypt, the Faculty of Fine Arts organised a big exhibition to display examples of achievements made by Egyptian artists belonging to different generation. The exhibition, which is organised in collaboration with the Ministry of Culture, the Sector of Fine Arts, and the Museum of Egyptian Modern Art, is sought as a chronicle of the birth and the evolution of the Egyptian fine arts. Works on display also shed light on artistic visions and techniques behind Egypt's 100 -years old process of creativity, which fruitfully contributed to the human art.
